As usual Literacy and Numeracy will follow the National Curriculum, we will be looking at The Emperor's New Clothes and the willow pattern story for our stimulus in literacy - the rest is as follows...

Science: For the first half term we will be looking at materials and their properties and in the second half how changes can occur to materials under different circumstances.
