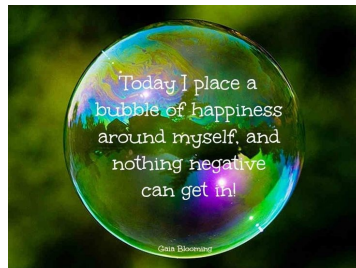

We await further advice from the government, but as of the most recent statement it looks as though full return for all year groups will not be until September.

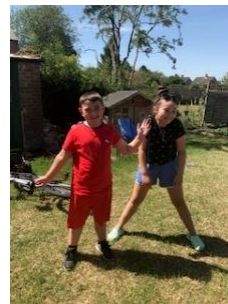
We know some of you will be anxious about transition to new classes, but please rest assured we will make ample time for transition in September.

Home Learning

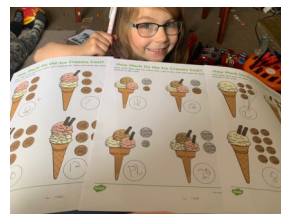
It continues to be wonderful to see all the incredible home learning you have been doing. What creative families you are !
