A huge welcome too, to our new Reception class, who have settled in so well, joining us for collective worship on their first day and behaving so well.

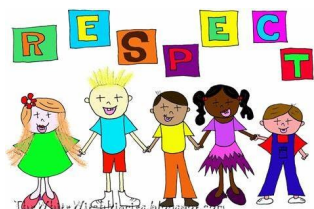
Our Christian value this term is **Love** and we will be also focussing on a **Love of Learning** mini project—
