
Summer Production:

Times Table Check:

This term, in June, Year 4 will be taking part in the Government's Times Table check, this will be completed in school time and will make sure that we let you know exactly what week we intend to take the tests, we have a 3 week period to complete them. In order to support your children with this we are still implementing our strict Times Table practice routine, which is as follows:

- Monday- Tackling Tables Test
- <u>Tuesday</u>- Tables Tuesday, we play games, sing songs etc to work through our tables
- <u>Wednesday</u>- individual times table test, this will be a test which focuses on one table at a time e.g. 4x times table, each week the children work through these.
- We will also be timetabling two sessions a week where the children will be using the governmental practice site, just so that the children become familiar with the set up.

In order to keep supporting your children with learning their times tables, remember, all the children have a log-in to the Tackling Tables App and are welcome to log-in and practice any time. Sum dog cab also be used to practise, and we will be setting a weekly Times Table homework for the whole class.


Reading:

We would like to emphasise again the importance of reading at home. The children should have a reading book at all times and should be filling in their reading journals daily. They may wish to include the following in their reading journals: new vocabulary/phrases and what they mean, points of interest in what they are reading, book predictions/what will happen next etc.



Reading journals will be checked and children will receive stickers if filled in properly. We have also started recording the books that children are reading each week, so that we can ensure that books are being read regularly and to encourage the children to stick with a reading book and not to flit from book to book.
