

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We use 'Tapestry' in Reception. Some of you are already familiar with this through our setting. However, for those of you that have yet to come across it, tapestry is an online learning journal and a great way for us to communicate between home and school. We are able to add observations regarding what your child has been up to, as well as class memos about relevant topics and activities. You are also able to add and share moments from home too! Therefore we would really appreciate your engagement with this. To create your account we require a permission slip to be completed and returned to school. If you have yet to set up an account, hard copies of the permission form will be sent home with your child this week.

A polite reminder that school starts at 8.45am. We will meet your child on the playground initially to support with the drop-off, and then walk up to the mobile as a class. Please ensure your child brings a book bag and a water bottle to school each day. Could they also please bring a pair of wellies to be kept in school. Any support you can give your child with learning to put on school shoes (we regularly move between indoors and outdoors) would be greatly appreciated, especially new ones!
